## Bill Henry

President, ForeSight Strategy Solutions

Bill Henry is president of ForeSight Strategy Associates in St. Paul, Minnesota. ForeSight is a consulting company that specializes in developing the governance and management capacity of nonprofit organizations and orienting healthcare organizations to new strategies.

Bill's work with nonprofit boards spans 30 years and includes research, teaching, speaking and publications, as well consultations to many organizations, largely in healthcare. He has directed the University of Minnesota's Trustee Education Program and teaches governance in the University's Masters in Healthcare Administration (MHA) program. Bill's articles on healthcare governance and emerging strategy have appeared in *Modern Healthcare*, *Trustee*, *Second Opinion*, *Hospitals and Health Systems* and *Postgraduate Medicine*.

Bill is faculty director for applied business and health systems management in the University of Minnesota's College of Continuing Education and is currently designing and implementing a new Executive Studies MHA program in the University's School of Public Health.

Bill has conducted research on the psychosocial problems of family practice residents, the emergence of integrative medicine, home care for children dying of cancer, rural-to-urban migration, poverty and other social issues. He was chief operating officer of the International Diabetes Center at Park Nicollet Medical Foundation for 9 years, during which he led the development of diabetes management programs in the U.S.S.R. and in hospitals and clinics in the United States. In 1990 he was awarded Medical Alley's Outstanding Achievement Award for his work with the U.S.S.R.

He has served as chair of the board of Gillette Children's Hospital in St. Paul, as trustee of Minneapolis Children's Hospital, and as president of the Metro Hospital Trustee Council. He is the founding president of Minnesota International Health Volunteers.
