David W. Adinolfi is currently a Director and Chairman of the Board of Ionix Medical, Inc., an early stage technology company developing novel medical devices to address benign prostatic hyperplasia and certain cancers.

From 1994 until 2005, Mr. Adinolfi was with St. Jude Medical, a medical device company engaged in the design, development, manufacture and distribution of medical devices for heart-related and neurological conditions. From 2001 to 2005, Mr. Adinolfi was President of the Daig Division of St. Jude Medical, responsible for the design, development and manufacture of products in the interventional cardiology and electrophysiology cardiovascular segments. From 1994 to 2001, Mr. Adinolfi held several senior executive positions with the Cardiac Rhythm Management Division of St. Jude Medical, including Sr. Vice President of Product Portfolio Management, Sr. Vice President of Global Marketing, Vice President of Global Product Planning and Vice President of Strategic Market and Business Development. From 1989 to 1994, Mr. Adinolfi was with Siemens Pacesetter, a division of Siemens Medical Corporation responsible for the design, development, manufacture and distribution of implantable devices for cardiac rhythm disorders. From 1984 to 1989, Mr. Adinolfi was with Cordis Corporation, a Johnson & Johnson company, with responsibilities ranging from Marketing, Sales, Clinical Research and Clinical Engineering.

Mr. Adinolfi currently serves on the Board of Directors for Ionix Medical, Inc., the Ridgeview Foundation, where he is also Chairman of the Finance Committee and a member of the Executive Committee, and CreateHealth, Inc., where he is also on the Compensation Committee and Finance and Investing Committee.
