Jim Dauwalter

Former Chairman, Entegris Corporation

Jim Dauwalter most recently served as the Chairman of Entegris Board of Directors, where he was a 33-year veteran with the Entegris organization. Prior to his appointment to Chairman, he served as the company's CEO since 2001. Prior to that, he served as Entegris' President and COO.

In his 33 years with the company, Jim held executive line and staff positions. He played a pivotal role in directing the growth of the company from 40 employees to approximately 1,800 employees, increasing sales in the semiconductor industry and other industries as well as expanding the company's operations to 14 worldwide manufacturing facilities. Dauwalter was instrumental in founding Metron Technology, which played a large role in the growth of the semiconductor supplier market in Europe.

Dauwalter has previously served on the board of directors of Fluoroware, Inc., Nippon Fluoroware K.K., Fluoroware-Valqua Japan K.K., Fluoroware Southeast Asia PTE Ltd. and Metron Technology B.V., US BioEnergy, and VeraSun Energy. He received a bachelor's degree in business management from Bemidji State University in 1973.

Jim is a life-long resident of Chaska and Carver and has dedicated many hours to community involvement including his service as a member and board member of Community Bank Chaska, Wallestad Foundation, his church, Chaska Chamber of Commerce, Chaska Rotary and the St. Francis Foundation. He was also one of the founding members of Christmas in May Chaska, and has served on numerous task forces for District 112. Currently, he is a board member of BioDrain, Vice President and board member of Hazeltine National Golf Club and is the Chairman of the 2009 PGA Championship.
